Grant Guidelines

Description

McLean County Farm Bureau® Foundation offers special funding to support Agricultural Education programs at high schools that teach McLean County Youth. Eligible schools:

- Normal Community
- Normal West
- Olympia

- Prairie Central
- Ridgeview
- Tri-Valley

Matching Requirement

FFA Chapters must match grant request in one of the following ways:

- 1. **Local contributions match** dollar for dollar match for funds contributed to the school for the same purpose as this grant request. Students must be involved in the fundraising process.
- 2. **Ag service project match** student volunteer hours matched at minimum wage rate (schools earn \$9.25 per hour per student). Volunteer hours must be at Ag related events.

Grant Program

- Grant funds must be used for ag education purposes (computers, equipment, programs, conferences, classroom needs, etc.)
- Up to \$1,000 will be available for each high school during the Matching Grant program year (August through April). Grant payments will be issued after December 1, 2019.
- Schools must submit the Grant Request online on or before **May 1, 2020** at www.mcfb.org/foundation/grants
- Funds may not be used for food, parties, awards or fundraising activities greenhouse plant sales count as fundraising activities.
