Grant Guidelines

Description

McLean County Farm Bureau® offers special funding to support Agricultural Education programs at high schools that teach McLean County Youth. Eligible schools:

- El Paso-Gridley
- Heyworth
- LeRoy
- Lexington
- Normal Community
- Normal West
- Olympia
- Prairie Central
- Ridgeview
- Tri-Valley

Capital Grant Program

- Grant funds must be used for capital projects related to ag education purposes. The grant is intended to fund physical items that will last multiple years including but not limited to:
 - Shop equipment, shop construction or remodel
 - Classroom construction, equipment or remodel
 - Greenhouse construction, equipment or remodel
 - Plot or other crops/livestock equipment – wagon, trailer, etc
- Up to \$15,000 will be available during the 2021-22 program year – to be distributed by Nov. 30, 2022
- Grant requests may include multi-year projects and/or projects for future years (completion dates Spring 2022 – Spring 2026)
- Schools must submit the Grant Request online on or before **May 1, 2022** at www.mcfb.org/grants
- Funds may not be used for food, parties, awards, conferences, competitions, travel or consumable items
