### Homegrown Ag Scholarship Eligibility

- Scholarship recipients must be a current McLean County Farm Bureau member or dependent of a current member

- NO Separate Application is required – these scholarships will be offered directly through the Financial Aid office of Heartland Community College and Illinois State University

### Heartland Community College Homegrown Ag Scholarships

- Must be a resident of McLean County, IL graduating from High School in May 2021 or a graduate of a McLean County High School (permanent address/parent/guardian residence in McLean County)
- Must be enrolled as a fulltime student and maintain good academic standing
- Must be pursuing an Associate's degree in Agriculture, Agriculture degree transfer program or Agriculture-related certificate program
- All students who meet the criteria will receive **\$500/semester** (\$1,000 per year) for up to 4 semesters

### Illinois State University Homegrown Ag Scholarships

- Must be a resident of McLean County, IL graduating from High School in May 2021 or a graduate of a McLean County High School (permanent address/parent/guardian residence in McLean County)
- Must be enrolled as a fulltime student and maintain good academic standing
- Must be pursuing a degree in Agriculture
- All students who meet the criteria will receive **\$500/semester** (\$1,000 per year) for up to 4 semesters (or until completing 60 credit hours)
- All students who meet the criteria will receive **\$1,000/semester** (\$2,000 per year) for up to 4 semesters (for 61 credit hours until degree completion or a 4<sup>th</sup> semester whichever comes first)
