Description

McLean County Farm Bureau® offers special funding to support Agricultural Education programs at high schools that teach McLean County Youth. Eligible schools:

Capital Grant Program

- Grant funds must be used for capital projects related to ag education purposes. The grant is intended to fund <u>physical items that will last multiple years</u> including but not limited to:
 - Shop equipment, shop construction or remodel
 - Classroom construction, equipment or remodel
 - Greenhouse construction, equipment or remodel
 - Plot or other crops/livestock equipment wagon, trailer, etc
- Up to \$15,000 will be available during the 2022-23 program year to be distributed by Oct. 31, 2023
- Grant requests may include multi-year projects and/or projects for future years (completion dates Spring 2023 Spring 2027)
- Schools must submit the Grant Request online on or before May 1, 2023 at <u>www.mcfb.org/grants</u>
- Funds may not be used for food, parties, awards, conferences, competitions, travel or consumable items
