Grant Guidelines

Description

McLean County Farm Bureau® Foundation offers special funding to support Agricultural Education programs at high schools that teach McLean County Youth. Eligible schools:

- El Paso-Gridley
- Heyworth

- Normal Community
- Normal West
- Olympia

- Prairie Central
- Ridgeview
- Tri-Valley

Service Project Matching Requirement

FFA Chapters must match grant requests with FFA student volunteer hours. Student volunteer hours will be matched at a rate of \$10 per hour (100 hours = \$1,000). **Maximum grant per chapter is \$1,000.**

- 1. Food & Farm Fun Zone during the McLean County Fair FFA Chapters can earn \$250 \$1,000 for student volunteer hours at the Food & Farm Fun Zone
- 2. Other ag-related/community volunteering FFA Chapters can earn up to \$750 for other service projects

Grant Program

- Grant funds must be used for ag education purposes (computers, equipment, shop equipment, programs, conferences, classroom needs, etc.)
- Up to \$1,000 will be available for each high school during the Matching Grant program year (August through April). Grant payments will be issued after December 1, 2023.
- Schools must submit the Grant Request online on or before **May 1, 2024** at www.mcfb.org/foundation/grants
- Funds may not be used for food, parties, awards or fundraising activities greenhouse plant sales count as fundraising activities.
